67% said the Club is where they learned how to "say no" to drugs and alcohol.

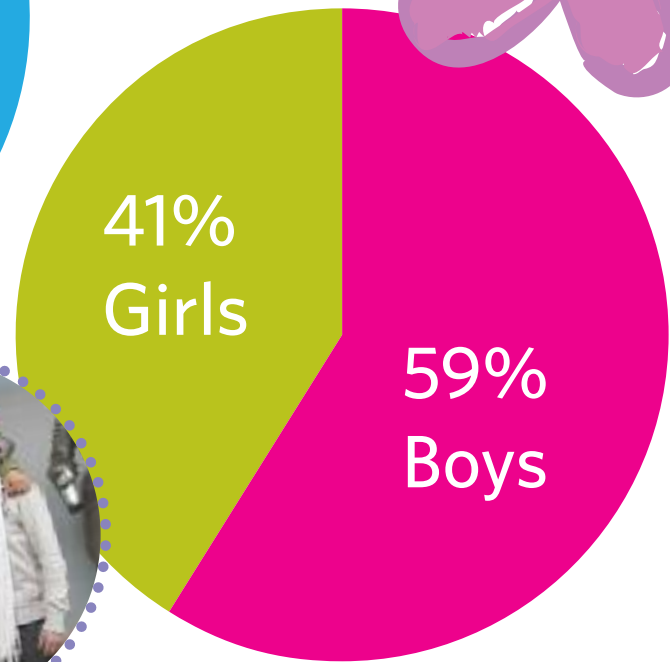
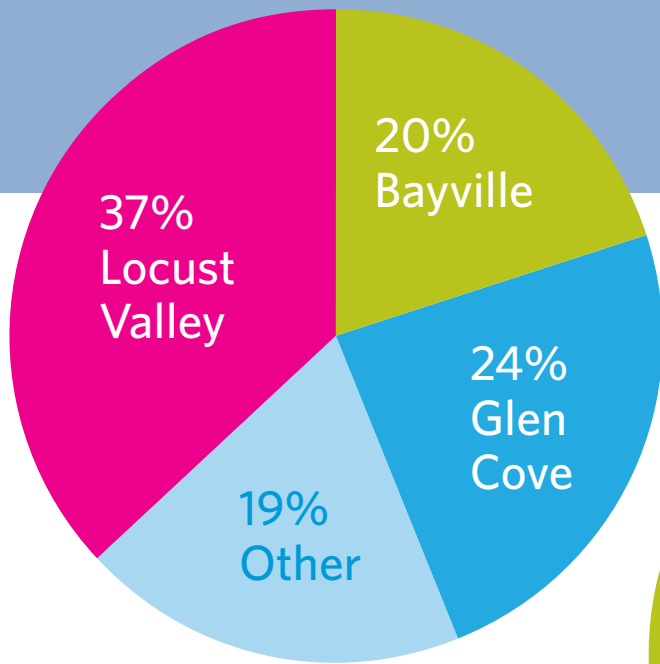
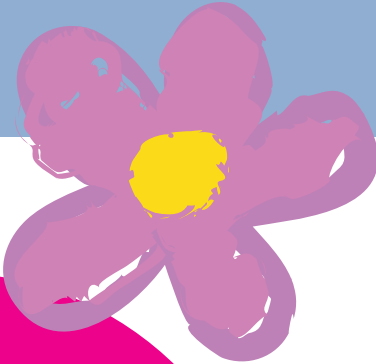
28% of our respondents reported they would have dropped out of high school if not for the Club.

Education & Career Development

Programs in this core program area enable youth to become proficient in basic educational disciplines, and apply learning to everyday situations to achieve success in a career.

This national program takes a holistic approach to educating boys and girls about good nutrition, making physical fitness a daily practice and developing individual strengths and good character. In addition to components for the mind and body, the Triple Play program gets at the soul of the Club experience - the gamesroom. Each mind, body and soul program component can stand alone, yet integrating them allows Club members to reap more powerful, lifelong benefits.

City Club (New Program)

The mission of this new GBBGC program is to raise cultural awareness and appreciation for the arts by introducing boys and girls to a variety of cultural events in New York City and the surrounding areas. This program ensures that children who might not otherwise have the opportunity will have access to our cultural institutions throughout New York. Fulfillment of the program's mission will lead students to discover the lifelong enjoyment and wonder inherent in dance, music, theater, and visual arts, and will connect them to a variety of arts institutions and organizations.

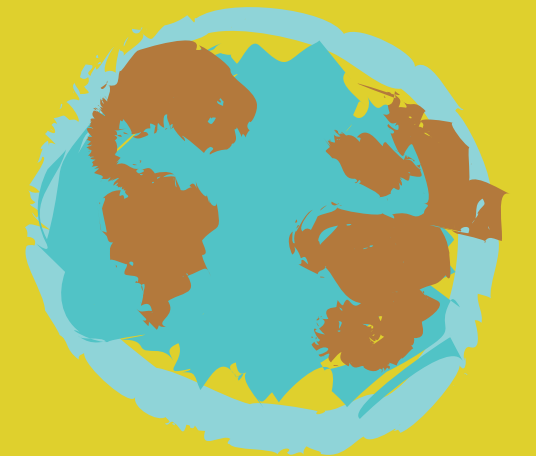
